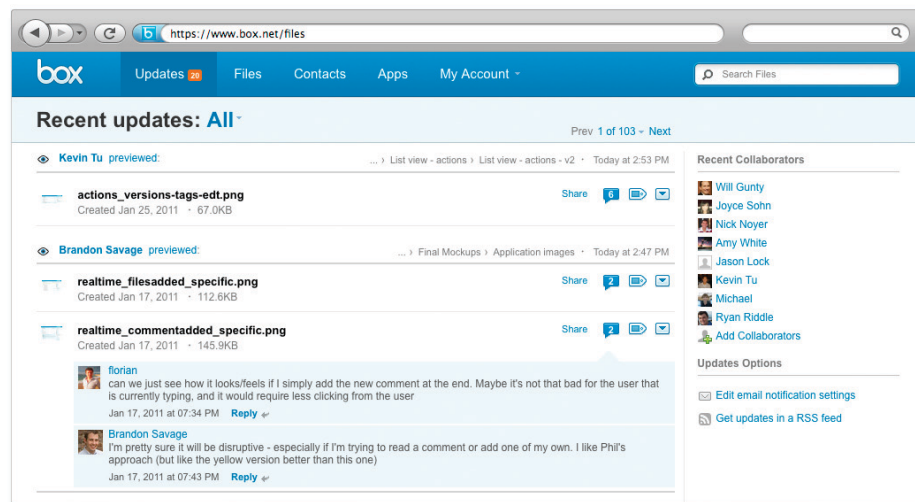

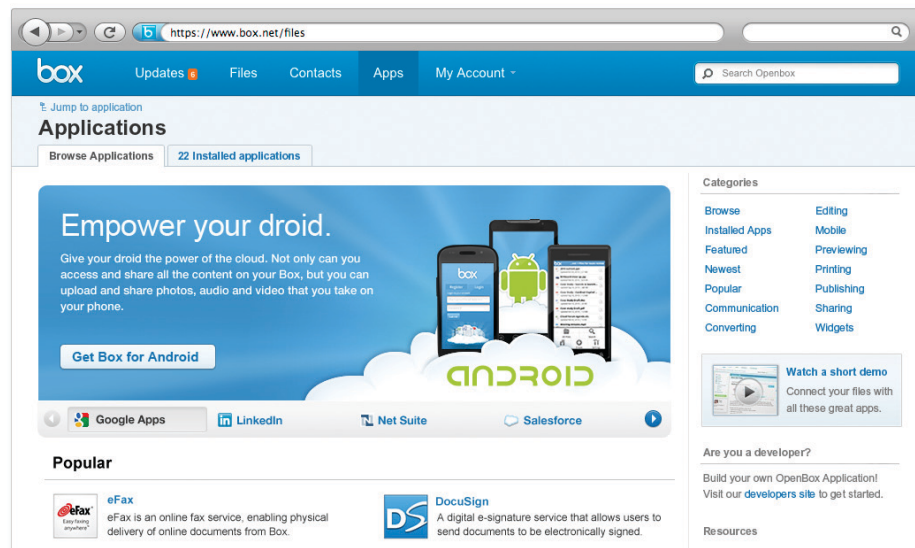

- **Secure data centers:** Your content is stored on enterprise-grade servers that undergo regular audits and are monitored 24/7
